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# Inflation Watch

The Bureau of Labor Statistics released the February Consumer Price Index on Thursday, March 17<sup>th</sup> and released the October Producer Price Index on Wednesday, March 16<sup>th</sup> 2011.

The following tables contain statistics on the Consumer Price Index (including the Median CPI), the Producer Price Index, the Personal Consumption Expenditure Index, and various subindices and special indices for all three.

#### **Consumer Price Inflation**

The Consumer Price Index rose **2.11%** from February 2010 to February 2011.

Within the eight major sub-groups:

Four groups are growing faster than the base rate. They comprise 37.46% of the index:

- Transportation (7.29%)
- Medical Care (2.84%)
- All Items less Food (2.13%)
- Food and Beverages (2.24%)

Five are growing slower than the base rate. They comprise 62.54% of the index:

- Housing (0.64%)
- Education and Communication (1.25%)
- Apparel (-0.36 %)
- Recreation (-0.15%)
- Other Goods and Services (1.97%)

The commonly watched special index, all items less food and energy (or "core rate"), rose **1.11%** in the February to February period.

Many prefer to watch the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland's Median CPI as a better measure of the "core rate." This index rose 1.11% on a year-over-year basis.

Two other special indices are notable on a year-overyear basis. The energy index **rose 10.84%** while the energy commodities index **rose 18.84%**.

#### **Personal Consumption Expenditures**

In the year ending **January** 2011, the PCE Index increased 1.22%. The "core" PCE Index (less food and energy) increased by 0.81%.

#### **Producer Price Inflation**

In the twelve months ending January 2011, the Producer Price Index for Finished Goods rose 5.78%, the Producer Price Index for Intermediate Goods rose 7.81%, and the Producer Price Index for Crude Materials rose 22.02%.

### Which Measure Do You Prefer: Core vs. Headline


The Federal Reserve's preference for core inflation rather than headline inflation has been discussed ad-nauseum. In fact, <u>Federal Reserve has even changed the way in which they refer to "inflation"</u> in an attempt to avoid the subject altogether.


Between this change in dialect and the recent explosion in food and energy prices, one might assume that the difference between these two measures is at a historic extreme.

As the charts below show, however, neither CPI (left) nor PCE (right) are currently that far above

their core counterparts on a historical basis. CPI has outpaced Core CPI by 0.96% in the year ending January 2011 while PCE has outpaced Core PCE by 0.41% over the same period.

At the height of the crisis in 2008 CPI was almost 3% higher than Core CPI. While a nearly 1% difference in these measures should not be discounted entirely, perhaps the Federal Reserve's obsession with core inflation is a bit overstated.
